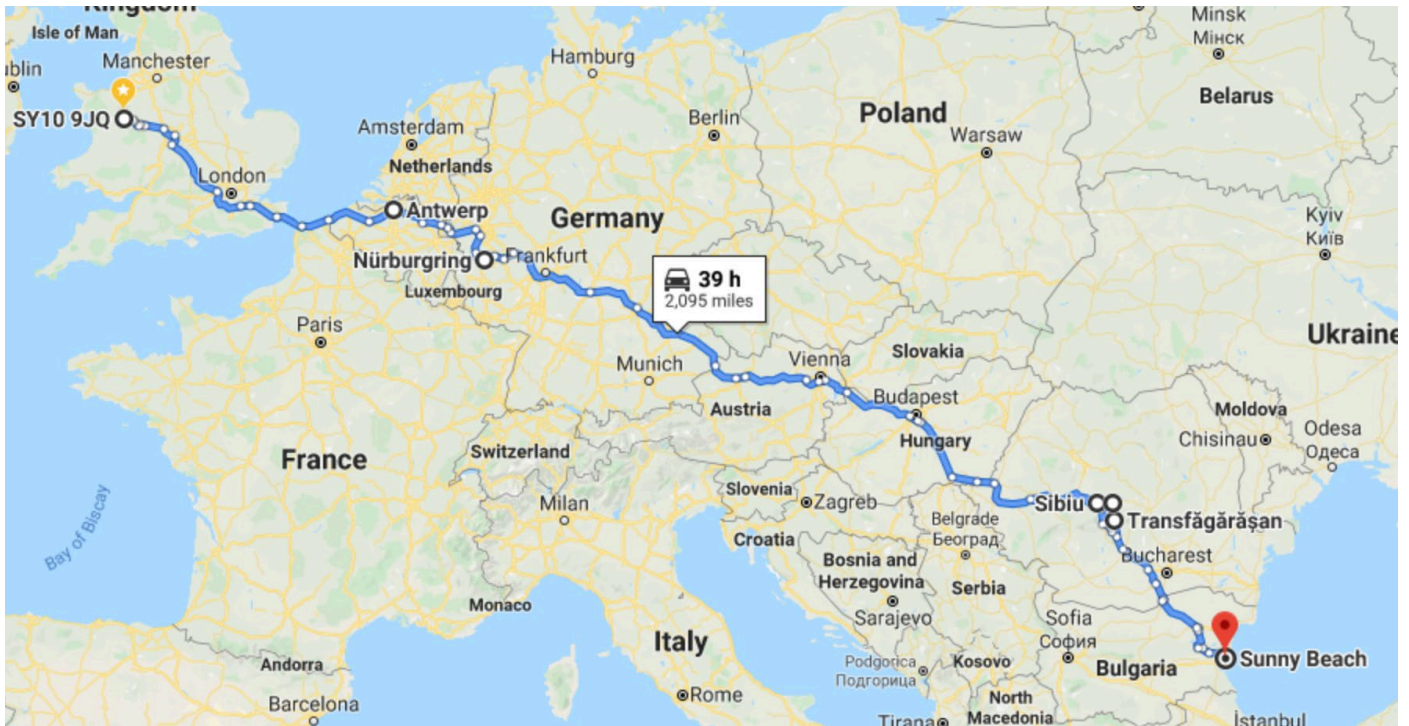

## Further Information

### What?

We are taking a little jaunt to Sunny Beach Bulgaria and welcome teams to join us for the journey

### When?

Leaving here at 10am Tuesday 15th September, back here by Sunday 20th September

### How?

Team of two in a European brand of car worth £500 or less, with a maximum of seven hours driving per day per driver. Teams of two cars so you can jump in another car if yours gets broken...

### Where?

- Day 1 - Here to Antwerp, Belgium overnight – 9 hours – 431 miles
- Day 2 – Antwerp to Nürburgring – 2 hours at the circuit for a gentle lap...onto Passau overnight – 9 hours – 564 miles
- Day 3 – Passau to Budapest for lunch, onto Deva, Romania overnight – 9.5 hours – 605 miles
- Day 4 – Deva to Bucharest via the Transfagarasan Road – Top Gears best road in the world – onto Sunny Beach – 10 hours – 447 miles
- Day 5 – Saturday – Celebrations
- Day 6 – Sunday – gentle flight home or prepare for a another 2,000 miles back...

### Why?

We will raise some money for the Air Ambulance, see countries and places we haven't seen before and possibly have a bit of fun – the target is £20,000 – Penybont GT raised £19,125 – it would be great to beat that.



### Why two people per car and two cars?

Because the car may not survive the journey, you jump in with your other team car. We are limiting entry to 20 cars maximum, so 10 teams and 40 people...

### How much? – Based on Jan 2020 prices

- Car: £500
- Deposit £100 per car – this is going into an emergency fund to help with anything not covered by drivers insurances
- Crossing £90
- Hotels £50 each maximum based on two sharing x 5 nights
- Fuel: Diesel car £200 – V8 Jag £450
- Insurance and breakdown cover £100
- Beer: £????
- Return flight: From £100 into London to £230 for Manchester
- From £745 per person including the car

### Terms and Conditions / Basic Team Rules

#### Car

**Condition** - Must be roadworthy, taxed, insured for driving in Europe

**Value** - Worth £500 or less on day of departure

**Make** – Must be a European make of car

**Spare Wheel** – Full sized spare wheel in good condition & tools to change a wheel – jack, wrench, locking wheel-nut tool

**Battery**- should be in good condition – Jim can do a health check

**Water** –old cars don't like warmer countries, carry a container for topping up

**Oil** – Carry enough engine oil for the car for topping up during the journey

**Logbook** – Carry logbook for car, its getting sold or scrapped in Bulgaria

**Foreign Roads Kit** – Warning Triangle, Headlamp Beam Deflectors, Alcohol Breath Testers, GB Sticker, Spare Bulb Kit, Hi Viz Vests – Halfords do a Europe travel kit, everything you need in a box

**Note:** We will carry a few extra bits, tools, jump leads, spare battery and other bits and bobs

#### Drivers

**Insurance** - Must be insured to drive the vehicle and hold a full driving licence for the type of vehicle used

**Insurance** – Proof of insurance should be carried in the car

**ID** – Must carry driving licence and passport

**Licence** – It is worth getting a European driving licence – they are £6 per country, just take your licence and passport into a Post Office and you get your European Driving Licence issued there and then

**Drink driving** - rules abroad are strict, morning drivers should not be late drinkers!

**Provisions** - Carry drinking water and food in case of breakdowns

**Breakdown Cover** – Check you have or get suitable breakdown cover with relay i.e. next stop point, we can collect you if the car is scrap

#### Hotels / Accommodation

**Where** – We are working with Polka Dot travel to book group accommodation – they are budgeting a maximum of £50 per person per night for our stays.

**Camping** – You can camp if you wish

**Food** – We plan to meet up for lunch each day, this will give everyone a chance to catch-up, fix anything that is hanging off and swap drivers for the afternoon leg

**Evening Meal** – Meeting up is optional and we can go on for an educational study tour of the local hostleries...

#### SatNav

Optional – we are looking to use the best route each day, only the destinations are key.

#### Liabilities

This is not an organised tour, just friends on a road-trip. Penybont Inn accept no responsibility and are not liable for any injuries or losses resulting directly or indirectly from this road-trip.

Teams are responsible for their own conduct and legal compliance.
